RESOLUTION NO. 94-135

WHEREAS, on March 11, 1994, the Hickiwan, Pisinemo, and Gu Vo Districts made a presentation to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the Governor's Alliance Against Substance Abuse; and

WHEREAS, the issue presented to the Legislative Council was tabled by Legislative Order No. 94-094 with the recommendation that the Human Resources Development Committee review this issue with the three districts; and

WHEREAS, an invitation was made to the three districts, Pisinemo, Hickiwan and Gu Vo, the Education Committee, and San Simon School Board to attend a meeting of the Human Resources Development Committee on March 24, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee did meet to discuss the three districts working with the Governor's Drug Policy Office to address drug and alcohol problems within the communities of Hickiwan, Pisinemo, and Gu Vo Districts; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the three districts to initiate after school and summer programs to address the drug and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council hereby approves of an appropriation of \$5,000
in matching funds to the alliance contingent upon
funding of the Western O'odham Community Alliance
(W.O.C.A.) by the Governor's Office of Drug Policy.**




