

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Instructing Chairman Sylvester Listo to Submit a
Formal Request to the IHS and BIA for Specific Information)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-149

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has a significant interest in protecting any and all funds which may be available pursuant to the terms and spirit of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975, and subsequent amendments; and

WHEREAS, implementation of Executive Order 12839 mandates without Tohono O'Odham participation may impact significantly on availability of present and future funds through the IHS and the BIA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council instructs Chairman Sylvester Listo to formally request the following information from the BIA and IHS:

- (a) a description of the function and scope of work of each BIA and IHS employee in the Tohono O'Odham Service zones;**
- (b) a line-item budget for each function and scope of work; and**
- (c) a description of any and all internal action taken to comply with the mandate of Executive Order 12839.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the position of the Tohono O'Odham Nation that all reductions in force incurred as a result of Executive Order 12839 shall be limited to

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**functions associated with the federal governments' trust
obligations and not impact, in any way, funds and/or
functions related to program and indirect costs.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation formally
petitions both the IHS and BIA to open on-the-record
formal dialogues regarding implementation of Executive
Order 12839.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 12TH day of APRIL, 1994 at a meeting at
which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,612.0 FOR; -0-
AGAINST; 151.0 NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) & (j) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
