**RESOLUTION NO. 94-159**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is devoted to the goal of  
safeguarding its citizens and its environment; and**

**WHEREAS, the possibility of emergencies arising from the spill of  
chemicals or other hazardous materials is a threat to  
the safety of Tohono O'Odham citizens and the Tohono  
O'Odham environment; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is obligated under federal  
law to comply with SARA Title III also known as the  
Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know-Act;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has  
made grant money available to Indian Tribes to pay for  
training for chemical emergencies; and**

**WHEREAS, FEMA requires a ten percent (10%) match of funds for  
receipt of the grant; and**

**WHEREAS, this ten percent match is a "soft" match and can be  
achieved through provision of training facilities, A-V  
equipment, and per diem and salaries of attending  
personnel.**

12 **and Community Right-To-Know-Act.**

14 **Legislative Council on the 2ND. day of MAY, 1994 at a meeting at**  
15 **which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,578.0 FOR; -0-**  
16 **AGAINST; 185.0 NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**  
17 **vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution**  
18 **of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
19 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
20 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**  
21 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
