> renovations (\$18,902.00), insurance (\$512.00) and office & communication equipment (\$26,466.00)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED upon termination of the 4 month lease agreement, the Tohono O'Odham Nation will either renew the lease or purchase the building at a predetermined price quote, taking into consideration the market value and state of the building.
