

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appropriating Supplemental Funding of \$52,280.00 to

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-164**

**WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch is in need of additional space in order to properly administer and pursue Court initiatives involving members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Branch is facilitating the transfer of a lease agreement between the U.S. Customs and GE Capital Modulaire Space; and**

**WHEREAS, upon careful assessment of the existing building through an inspection report, dialogue with representatives from Executive, GE Capital Modulaire Space, Legislative, Judiciary, and Budget & Finance Committees, the Judicial Branch deems it proper and necessary to proceed with the transfer and requests a special appropriation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it authorizes an appropriation of \$52,280.00 from the Nation's General Revenue Account to continue the lease agreement between GE Capital Modulaire Space and the Tohono O'Odham Nation, for 4 months at a monthly lease price of \$1,600.00 per month (\$6,400.) plus**

**renovations (\$18,902.00), insurance (\$512.00) and office  
& communication equipment (\$26,466.00)**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED upon termination of the 4 month lease  
agreement, the Tohono O'Odham Nation will either  
renew the lease or purchase the building at a pre-  
determined price quote, taking into consideration the  
market value and state of the building.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council on the 5TH. day of MAY, 1994 at a meeting at  
which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,583.0 FOR; -0-  
AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 180.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the  
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


