**WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council convened in a regular
scheduled meeting held on April 09, 1994 with a quorum
present; and**

**WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council heard the presentation
made by Mr. John Fendenheim of his intent to establish
O'Odham Trading - Native American Arts & Wares, a
retail establishment on the Schuk Toak District of the
Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council heard Mr. John
Fendenheim state that he will be the owner of O'Odham
Trading - Native American Arts & Wares, which he plans
to establish at the San Pedro road turnoff at Highway 86;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council is aware that
presentation of establishing O'Odham Trading - Native
American Arts & Wares, was prior presented and
approved by the San Pedro Community; and**

**WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council has determined that the
routing and location of O'Odham Trading - Native
American Arts & Wares is not in conflict with any land
use plans adopted by the District Council; and**

(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
