BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
