3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has provided preventive**
4 **health care for women, infants and children during**
5 **Fiscal Year 1994; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from**
7 **the United States Department of Agriculture for**
8 **programs designed to benefit women, infants and**
9 **children; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has entered into a**
12 **Memorandum of Agreement with Inter-Tribal Council of**
13 **Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and**
14 **Children (WIC) program; and**

16 **WHEREAS, services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial**
17 **and services continue to be necessary to help alleviate**
18 **nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
19 **individuals at risk.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham**
23 **Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the**
24 **application for funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of**
25 **Arizona, to continue to operate and provide services to**
26 **eligible women, infants and children.**

3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the term of this Memorandum of
4 Agreement will commence on October 01, 1994 through
5 September 30, 1995 unless extended by mutual
6 agreement of both parties.

8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
9 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund
10 or operate the program in the interim while
11 negotiations are still being conducted and no executed
12 Agreement has been approved by the Inter-Tribal
13 Council of Arizona.

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to
17 wit: the Chairman and any designated official are
18 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
19 Memorandum of Agreement, provided however, that any
20 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
21 the Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for
22 further prior approval by this Council.
