

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1995 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-202**

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Tribal**  
4 **Employment Rights Office since 1978 and has**  
5 **successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'Odham; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'Odham Tribal Employment**  
7 **Rights Office has been supplemented by the Equal**  
8 **Employment Opportunity Commission; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment**  
11 **Rights Office is essential to eradicate employment**  
12 **discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the**  
13 **Tohono O'Odham Nation.**

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15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham**  
16 **Legislative Council that it hereby approves the**  
17 **continued supplemental funding for the Tribal**  
18 **Employment Rights Office from the Equal Employment**  
19 **Opportunity Commission.**

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22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall**  
23 **commence on October 01, 1994 through September 30,**  
24 **1995.**

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26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
27 **Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to**  
28 **wit: the Chairman and any designated Official are**

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3 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,  
4 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
5 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted  
6 for further prior approval by this Council.  
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8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham  
9 Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of JUNE, 1994 at a meeting at  
10 which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,665.0 FOR; -0-  
11 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 98.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the  
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the  
13 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
14 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
15 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
16 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
