RESOLUTION NO. 94-204

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) funds are made available to State and Tribal Governments from the Department of Economic Security to establish employment and training programs for improving the employment prospects of eligible persons; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network of employment and training programs throughout the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the JTPA Program submits the following documents for review and approval for the Title IIB Contract Proposal for Fiscal Year 1995:

- 1. Fiscal Year 1995 Administrative Cost Pool Budget in the amount of \$12,707.00; and**
- 2. Fiscal Year 1995 Program Budget in the amount of \$108,008.00
For a grand total amount of \$120,715.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the Title IIB contract proposal and budgets in the amount of \$120,715.00 for the delivery of JTPA services.
