3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the**
4 **JTPA/JOBS Title II Program funded by the Department of**
5 **Health and Human Services, Family Support**
6 **Administration (DHHS/FSA); and**

8 **WHEREAS, Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was**
9 **enacted into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC**
10 **Program to emphasize work, child support, and family**
11 **benefits, to amend Title IV of the Social Security Act, to**
12 **encourage and assist needy children and parents under**
13 **the program to obtain the education, training and**
14 **employment needed to void long term welfare**
15 **dependence; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the JOBS Program has submitted a budget for Fiscal Year**
19 **1995 for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Legislative Council.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the FY**
24 **1995 JOBS Program Budget and authorizes expenditures**

6 **negotiations are still being conducted and no executed**
7 **grant has been awarded by the Department of Health**
8 **and Human Services, Family Support Administration.**

10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
11 **Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to**
12 **wit: the Chairman and any designated official are**
13 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
14 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the**
15 **funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted**
16 **for further prior approval by this Council.**

20 **Legislative Council on the 7TH day of JUNE, 1994 at a meeting at**
21 **which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0-**

23 **vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution**
24 **of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
26 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**
27 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
