

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1995 Food Distribution and Family Nutrition
Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-210

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated successfully a program whereby the diet and nutritional needs of eligible Tohono O'Odham have been served by supplementing other federal social service programs; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution/Family Nutrition Services has been provided through the United States Department of Agriculture; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Food Distribution Program is essential to provide basic diet and nutrition for eligible clients; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Food distribution and Family Nutrition Program has submitted a budget for Fiscal Year 1995 for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution and Family Nutrition Program from the United States Department of Agriculture.

10 Department of Agriculture unless approved by mutual
11 agreement of both contracting parties.

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
14 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to
15 wit: the Chairman and any designated official are
16 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
17 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
18 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted
19 for further prior approval by this Council.

28 **of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
