

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-213**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation submitted a P. L. 93-638 request to contract with the Bureau of Reclamation ("Reclamation"), as approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 92-271, to complete the predesign and design work associated with the Nation's farm projects; and**

**WHEREAS, in October 1993, after extensive negotiations with Reclamation, the Tohono O'Odham Nation entered into a three-year P. L. 93-638 Cooperative Agreement (No. 3-FC-32-00200, Council Resolution No. 93-356) with Reclamation to pursue the completion of predesign and design for the Schuk Toak New Farm; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council supported the Cooperative Agreement with the understanding that the Agreement would provide immediate partial funding for Fiscal Year 1994 and that further negotiations would take place between the Nation and Reclamation for additional funding and expansion of the scope of work consistent with the Nation's original proposal; and**

**WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has submitted a budget estimate for Fiscal Year 1995 including Direct Costs, Indirect Costs and Consultant costs totalling \$892,371.00, to continue efforts for the completion of predesign and design for the Schuk Toak New Farm Project.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the Fiscal Year 1995 budget estimate to continue the Schuk Toak projects as presented by the Water Projects Office.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation shall seek reimbursement of funds previously advanced by the Nation for costs which are the responsibility of the Secretary of Interior under SAWRSA.**


**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Water Projects Office, the Executive Office and other departments to continue to negotiate with Reclamation to achieve full funding for the completion of the design of the Schuk Toak New Farm project and authorizes and directs the Chairman of the Nation to execute any modifications to the**
