**WHEREAS, due to the sensitivity of the information to be presented, the Investment Committee suggested that this status report be heard in Closed Session; and**

**WHEREAS, in accordance with Article I, Section 1.F., of the Legislative Rules, a motion was made to formally close the session to address this item.**
