RESOLUTION NO. 94-232

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation serves its O'odham members with commodity foods to provide nutritional and supplemental meals; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Needy Family Food Program serves approximately 1,000 O'odham participants in Fiscal Year 1994 with expectant increases in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Warehouse is a vital and necessity in the operation and success of the Needy Family Food Program; and

WHEREAS, the Warehouse is in dire need of renovations to meet Federal Guidelines on contamination requirements and to safeguard the foods stored for distribution, and to insure there is no further jeopardy to the safety and welfare of employees and participants; and

WHEREAS, the U.S.D.A. has mandated major renovations or to close down the operations of this Program; and

WHEREAS, the renovation costs are estimated between a high of \$57,300.00 and a low of \$47,200.00; and
