

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Memoranda of Agreement Regarding Sinkhole  
and Bank Stabilization Studies Affecting the  
San Xavier Cooperative Farm)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-245**

**WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, the San Xavier District and Representatives of the Allottees recognize that the lands within the Cooperative Farm in the San Xavier District are being eroded and may be deemed unusable as part of the proposed Farm Rehabilitation and Extension Projects; and**

**WHEREAS, all parties acknowledge that studies should be conducted as soon as possible to assess problems associated with sinkholes within the Farm and stabilization of the banks of the Santa Cruz River adjacent to the Farm; and**

**WHEREAS, the parties have been negotiating for several months over acceptable contractual provisions which would enable the Bureau of Reclamation to proceed with these studies; and**

**WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee, the San Xavier District, the San Xavier Cooperative Association, and the San Xavier Allottees Association recommend that the**

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**Legislative Council approve the Memoranda of Agreement accompanying this Resolution.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council approves the Memorandum of Agreement among the Tohono O'Odham Nation, the Bureau of Reclamation and the San Xavier District regarding the sinkhole study, in the form attached hereto.**
- 2. The Legislative Council approves the Memorandum of Agreement among the Tohono O'Odham Nation, the Bureau of Reclamation and the San Xavier District regarding the bank stabilization study, in the form attached hereto.**
- 3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute each of the foregoing Memoranda of Agreement.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 24TH. day of JUNE, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 08 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article XVII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**


