**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health care  
of the Children of the Nation a priority; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Children have an average of 1.3  
diopters of Astigmatism; and**

**WHEREAS, these children are likely to have a vision that would not  
correct to 20/20; and**

**WHEREAS, the presence of Amblyopia also known as Lazy Eye is a  
disease that must be treated when a child is very young;  
and**

**WHEREAS, treatment may not be effective after the age of seven (7)  
years.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council approves and endorses the Nation's  
participation in the Astigmatism and Amblyopia  
Prevention Project.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council on the 12TH. day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at  
which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0-  
AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
