

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving \$3,814.00 Appropriation for O'Odham in Mexico
Human Rights Conference)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-265

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports O'Odham in Mexico and is desirous of learning more about existing human rights violations and conditions affecting their welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Traditional O'Odham Leaders ,(TOL), officially sanctioned the sponsoring of a O'Odham in Mexico Human Rights Conference on July 29 & 30, 1994 for the purposes of educating tribal, state and national officials and the general public about O'Odham in Mexico issues, concerns, needs and existing international laws; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Conference is \$9,771.00 with contributions totalling \$5,957.00 having been secured; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$3,814.00 is necessary to cover the remaining expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby appropriates \$3,814.00 to assist with the O'Odham in Mexico Human Rights Conference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the source of the appropriation will be the General Revenue Account.




