RESOLUTION NO. 94-266

**WHEREAS, the Legislative and Executive Branches of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation will jointly sponsor the O'Odham
Human Rights Conference on July 29 and 30 in Sells; and**

**WHEREAS, the purpose of this Conference is to open O'Odham
community dialogue on such common issues as the
environment, protection of sacred sites, community
development, land acquisition, recognition of traditional
self-governance and spiritual expression; and**

**WHEREAS, it is in the O'Odham community public interest to insure
maximum participation by O'Odham in Mexico in the
dialogue.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch of the
Tohono O'Odham Nation shall make formal application
to the District Director of the Immigration and
Naturalization Service to parole into the United States
certain persons to participate in the O'Odham Human
Rights Conference.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the finding of the Tohono
O'Odham Legislative Council that this application is**

on both sides of the international boundary.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham

which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,612.0 FOR; -0-
AGAINST; 151.0 NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


