

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement  
with the Arizona Board of Regents for the Custody, Care  
and Preservation of the Norton Allen Collection  
and its Use by the Tohono O'Odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-269**

**WHEREAS, a unique and valuable collection of ancient cultural materials, of O'Odham origin, collected by Norton Allen is in need of preservation; and**

**WHEREAS, Norton and Ethel Allen desire to give this collection to the Arizona State Museum, the University of Arizona for curation, in such a manner that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will have access to the collection for cultural and educational purposes including in a museum established by the Nation at some time in the future; and**

**WHEREAS, the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Board of Regents and the Tohono O'Odham Nation provides for the preservation and curation of the Allen Collection with recognition that the first priority for use of the materials will be for educational purposes associated with the Nation's proposed museum, or other related Tohono O'Odham educational activities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement proposed with the Arizona Board of Regents provides for the loan of the materials in the Collection to the Nation, and for development of procedural guidelines for implementing**

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the agreement, facilitated by consultation services provided by the Arizona State Museum; and

**WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement proposed with the Arizona Board of Regents provides for an important step forward, not only for preservation of this valuable collection, but also for the benefit of the O'Odham people in furthering knowledge of their own historic traditions and involvement of the Tohono O'Odham Nation in museum curation and preservation of cultural materials.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby approves the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement, in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman to sign the same on behalf of the Nation.**


**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,650.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 113.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


