

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Agreement to Comply with Department of Housing
and Urban Development's Terms and Conditions
for Indian HOME Grant Assistance)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-270

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is applying for HOME grant Assistance funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to provide both substantial and moderate renovation of homes for low income families; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council elected to adopt a resolution to apply for the HUD Indian HOME grant; and

WHEREAS, a condition of application is to provide leverage funds by the Nation equalling 100% of the \$1.5 million requested in the Tohono O'Odham Nation's grant funds requested and \$1.5 million have been requested in the Tohono O'Odham Nation's HOME grant proposal; and

WHEREAS, nothing in this resolution is intended to waive, nor should any terms herein, or in the HOME grant proposal, be read or implied to waive the Tohono O'Odham Nation's sovereign immunity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Nation agrees to appropriate \$1,500,000.00 of funds of the Nation to match the award

made by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, if the Nation's grant proposal is chosen in the competitive selection of the 1994 HOME program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Nation agrees to comply with all terms and conditions expressed in HUD's Notice of Funds Availability announcing HOME grant assistance (published in the Federal Register Thursday, March 10, 1994), applicable provisions of 24 CFR part 92, Home Investment Partnership Program, provisions of any grant agreement entered into with HUD, and any other stipulations made by HUD and agreed to in writing by a duly authorized representative of the Tohono O'Odham Nation pertaining to the grant assistance provided by HUD.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,438.0 FOR; 325.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


