3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Department of Planning**  
4 **and Research provides the Nation with information on**  
5 **all matters relating to geographic, social, and economic**  
6 **development on the reservation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Research is in the**  
9 **process of developing a Geographic Information System**  
10 **(GIS) for the Nation; and**

11  
12 **WHEREAS, the transportation layer of the GIS plays an important**  
13 **role in the system as it relates to many other issues and**  
14 **programs on the reservation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, it is important that the reservation transportation**  
16 **system layer on the GIS be accurate to support other**  
17 **programs such as emergency services; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is required to develop and**  
20 **maintain a Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) that**  
21 **identifies the overall transportation improvement needs**  
22 **of the Nation and identifies priorities to report to the**  
23 **BIA and State of Arizona; and**

26 **WHEREAS, funds are authorized by the Intermodal Surface**  
27 **Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1991 for Indian**

**tribes to contract under P. L. 93-638 to perform transportation studies; and**

**WHEREAS, a part of the transportation planning process is to develop a transportation layer for the GIS.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation requests a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update the Nation's transportation plan and to develop a transportation layer for the Nation's GIS.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation reserves the right to identify locations and sites within the transportation layer of the GIS as confidential and to limit public access to such information.**


