

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of a Two Cohort Design for the "Obesity
Prevention in American Indian Children" Intervention
Study Sponsored by the National Institutes of
Health)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-276

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health and care of the children of the Tohono O'Odham Nation as a priority of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community has awarded a grant from the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI) of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to participate as a Field Center in the national study "Obesity Prevention in American Indian Children"; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, in cooperation with the Gila River Indian Community and the University of Arizona, has been actively participating in meetings of the Steering Committee for this study related to design and measurement issues; and

WHEREAS, the Steering Committee is attempting to decide whether to utilize a one-cohort or two-cohort research design for the second phase of the study; and

WHEREAS, the two-cohort design has the potential to benefit a

greater number of children of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council calls upon the Steering Committee to approve the two-cohort design for the full implementation phase of this study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or in his absence the Vice Chairman is hereby authorized to sign and execute such documents so as to fulfill the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


