

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing the Submittal of a Grant Application, Workplan,  
and Budget to the United States Environmental  
Protection Agency for funding under the Indian  
Environmental General Assistance Grant Program**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-277**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned about the  
health of its citizens and the integrity of its environment  
and,**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has taken steps to protect  
its citizens and its environment by applying for and  
receiving grant money from the United States  
Environmental Protection Agency under the multi-media  
Indian environmental grant program; and**

**WHEREAS, this is the last year of the Multi-Media Indian  
Environmental Grant Program and now the United  
States Environmental Protection Agency has made  
further funding available to Tribes under the Indian  
Environmental General Assistance Grant Program; and**

**WHEREAS, in order to receive this funding, a grant application  
workplan and budget must be submitted.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham  
Legislative Council hereby authorizes the submittal of  
a grant application, workplan, and budget to the United  
States Environmental Protection Agency for funding**

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**under the Indian Governmental General Assistance  
Grant Program**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to  
wit: the Chairman and any designated official are  
hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract  
provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
funding or funding levels of the contract shall be  
submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council on the 14TH day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at  
which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0-  
AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers  
vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy  
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


