

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Submission of the FY 1994
ICDBG Grant Application)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-279

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through its Research and Planning Department did advise the Communities and Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation of the availability of funds and types of eligible projects for the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Indian Community Development Block Grant Program (ICDBG); and

WHEREAS, the following communities and Districts did request the identified Projects:

Comobabi/Schuk Toak	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
Pisinemo/Pisinemo	H o m e R e n o v a t i o n / Wastewater Facilities
San Miguel/Chukut Kuk	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
Santa Rosa/Gu Achi	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
Florence Village/Gu Achi	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
San Xavier/San Xavier	Community Facilities
San Xavier/San Xavier	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities

WHEREAS, the total ICDBG projects exceeds the Nation's FY-1994 grant ceiling limit of \$2,000,000.; and

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WHEREAS, ICDBG will not rate and rank an application if the request for ICDBG funds exceeds the grant ceiling limit; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the prioritization of the projects requested of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the following projects are recommended for submission to ICDBG for the FY 1994 grant cycle:

Comobabi/Schuk Toak	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
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Pisinemo/Pisinemo	Home Renovation/ Wastewater Facilities
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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the two (2) identified infrastructure projects are hereby authorized for submission to ICDBG for the FY 1994 grant cycle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any outstanding ICDBG obligations regarding audit findings be dealt with immediately in resolving the discrepancies and not jeopardize the proposed projects.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council directs the Executive Office to expedite the


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
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Nation's FY 92 Audit and thus bring the Tohono O'Odham Nation into compliance with the Department of HUD requirements by July 31, 1994.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of JULY, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
