**RESOLUTION NO. 94-282** 

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is submitting an application for a grant to fund the following home renovation projects: Comobabi, Pisinemo, under the Indian Community Development Block Grant Program and in connection with the approved grant, resolves and makes certain assurances: and

WHEREAS, prior to the submission of this amendment request, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided tribal citizens, especially those living in areas where activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate information concerning the amount of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities, the range of activities that may be assisted, and other important program requirements, and solicited their views and participation; and

the traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement were followed through District Council meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs, express preferences about proposed community development and housing activities, assist in the selection of district priorities, and otherwise participate in the development of the application; and

WHEREAS.

WHEREAS, comments or views expressed by Tribal members were considered and modified the application accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the modified application has been made available to Tribal members for review and comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham

Legislative Council hereby certifies that the Tohono
O'odham Nation provided its citizens with the
opportunity to participate in the development of the
proposed Community Development Block Grant request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no part of this paragraph shall be constructed to restrict the responsibility and authority of the applicant for development of the application and the execution of its Community Development Block Grant program. Accordingly, the citizen participation requirements of this paragraph do not include concurrence by any person or group involved in citizen participation in making final determinations concerning the findings and contents of this amendment. The sole responsibility and authority to make such final determinations rest exclusively with the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
