**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health care
of the Children of the Nation a priority; and**

**WHEREAS, there are currently no school based health services in
day school on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Indian Health Services Clinic in Sells, Santa Rosa,
and San Xavier have few ongoing preventive clinical
services for children over age 5 without significant
obvious health problems; and**

**WHEREAS, San Simon School and Tohono O'odham High School are
40 minutes from the nearest Medical Center; and,**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is concerned about the rising
incidence of diabetes, alcohol, and substance abuse,
violence and gang membership, and teen pregnancy
among the youth of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and,**

**WHEREAS, a comprehensive school based Health Center would help
deliver immediate care for common and emergent
complaints, as well as help screen for and manage youth
at risk for those health problems listed above; and**
