Department of Public Safety; and WHEREAS,

the Gaming Office recommends that the procedure for conducting background investigations be amended to allow for the submission of only one set of fingerprints 2 3

WHEREAS,

rather than the current procedure which, in some cases, requires the submission of two sets of fingerprints; and the Gaming Office has negotiated a Memorandum of Understanding with the State Gaming Agency, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, which provides for the efficient processing of applicant fingerprints and assures that the Gaming Office shall be provided complete criminal history record information on each applicant for purposes of making an independent and informed determination as

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

 The Nation's Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with the Arizona State Gaming Agency in the form attached hereto.

2. The Tohono O'odham Police Department is designated as the law enforcement agency which will be taking the fingerprints of gaming license applicants.
