

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Amendment to Papago Council  
Ordinance #13-82)**

**WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District Council resolution #07-94-01  
hereby recommends an amendment to Papago Council  
Ordinance #13-82 with respect to the "General Mining  
Proceeds Distribution"; and**

**WHEREAS, a proposal to increase the mining proceeds distribution  
percentage to Sif-Oidak District was also presented  
which outlines the justification for the request; and**

**WHEREAS, the amendment is necessary to the Ordinance itself,  
pursuant to Ordinance #55, on behalf of the District IIM  
accounts which are no longer in existence.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council that it does hereby support and  
approve an amendment to the General Mining proceeds  
distribution as follows:**

**General Mining Proceeds - Proceeds derived from the  
mining of ore bearing rock, coal, asphalt, oil or gas and  
allied substances shall be divided as follows:**

- (1) Thirty-five percent (35%) thereof shall be  
deposited to the general account of the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation to be expended under budgets or  
resolutions of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**

**Council, along with other tribal revenue, for the use and benefit of the Tohono O'Odham Nation;**

**(2) Twenty-percent (20%) thereof shall be deposited to the Account of the District from whose lands the proceeds were produced, to be expended under budgets or resolutions of the District's Council duly approved by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council;**

**(3) Forty-five percent (45%) thereof shall be deposited into Accounts or other interest bearing accounts and added to the funds presently on deposit in accounts established pursuant to Ordinance No. 55, and shall be held invested and reinvested for the benefit of the eleven (11) Districts of the Tohono O'Odham Nation until the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council shall by resolution or superseding ordinance appropriate the funds in said accounts to or for the benefit of the various Districts of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Ordinance be further amended where necessary and enforced.**

**The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH. day of JULY, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of 736.0 FOR; 897.0 AGAINST; 130.0 NOT VOTING; AND 02 ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.**


