3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the**
4 **Early Childhood Head Start Program, Day Care Center**
5 **for its young members by providing for their welfare**
6 **through various programs and services designed to**
7 **meet their special needs; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,**
10 **Administration for Children and Family established a**
11 **Child Care and Development Block Grant Program to**
12 **provide grants to tribal governments to administer child**
13 **care programs; and**

15 **WHEREAS, P. L. 101-508 of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act**
16 **of 1990, section 5082, provides provision that the**
17 **Secretary shall reserve not more than 3 percent of the**
18 **amount appropriated in each fiscal year for payments**
19 **to Indian tribes and tribal organizations; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the block grant is to assist states**
23 **to provide child care services to low-income, working**
24 **families, (The Family Support Act requires child care**
25 **services for AFDC parents who are participating in the**
26 **JOBS training, and for one year after obtaining**

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation Early Childhood Head Start Program has submitted a Plan under this program through this block grant; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is desirous to continue to provide Day Care Services to its young tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation Early Childhood Head Start Program has submitted documentation to the Funding Agency for the Nation's allocation in the amount of \$431,859.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the Tohono O'Odham Child Care Development Block Grant Program Plan for federal assistance in order to provide Day Care Services to its young tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program will submit for review and approval a budget reflecting the Nation's allocation of \$431,859.



5 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted
6 for further prior approval by this Council.

10 which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,405.0 FOR; -0-
11 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 358.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
13 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
14 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
15 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
16 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
