3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the August**  
4 **05, 1994, General Session heard Cattle and Drought**  
5 **Concerns from Baboquivari District; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Officials from the Sif Oidak and Hickiwan Districts were**  
7 **in attendance and presented similar concerns from**  
8 **their respective areas; and**

9  
10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Representatives voiced the need for water**  
11 **and feed for the livestock in their respective areas; and**

12  
13 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Chairman by memorandum dated July 22,**  
14 **1994 requested input from the districts regarding the**  
15 **drought and its impact on livestock in order to**  
16 **schedule a meeting to develop a plan to deal with this**  
17 **issue; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District met with their District cattle**  
20 **owners and felt that the needs were immediate and that**  
21 **relief be sought now, rather than after the Chairman's**  
22 **proposed meeting.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham**  
25 **Legislative Council that it hereby schedules a Special**  
26 **Meeting on Monday, August 08, 1994 to specifically**  
27 **address the cattle and drought crisis.**


