

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating \$23,000 and Approving a Consultant Contract
for Legislative and Administrative Advocacy)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-326

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 93-190 the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council indicated its commitment to be part of the development and management of the Pinacate and Gran Desierto del Altar Biosphere Reserve; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 93-459, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council designated official O'odham Representatives for issues regarding the Pinacate/Gran Desierto Biosphere Reserve; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation and the Governor of the O'odham in Mexico did mutually sign and send a letter to the Mexican officials in charge of the Biosphere Reserve to indicate that the O'odham on both sides of the border planned to participate in the development and management of the Pinacate and Gran Desierto Biosphere Reserve; and

WHEREAS, under Article XVI, Section 9 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation it is mandated that the Nation attempt to restore the lands of historic Papaguera, and

WHEREAS, under Article XVIII, Sections 1 and 2 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation it is mandated that the

Nation preserve sacred sites and cultural values and fulfill its responsibilities as trustee of the environment for succeeding generations; and

WHEREAS, state and federal repatriation laws call for the return of numerous sacred and ceremonial objects as well as human remains to the custody of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has the oversight responsibility regarding issues affecting the Pinacates and repatriation; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee does not have time to respond adequately to all the issues that have and are developing in regard to the Pinacates and repatriation issues; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to create executive departments in order to implement the policies of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee recommends that a Consultant Contract be entered into with Kim H. Robinson to run through the end of the Nation's fiscal year, and that the Contract be subject to modification to extend its term upon the agreement of the parties,

and that the Consultant will work under the direction of the Cultural Preservation Committee and in consultation with the Chairman of the Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves a Consultant Contract with Kim H. Robinson, in the amount of \$23,000 and in the form attached hereto.**
- 2. The Legislative Council appropriates the sum of \$23,000 from the General Revenue Account to pay the fees and expenses under the Consultant Contract**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH. day of AUGUST, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,218.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 269.0 NOT VOTING; and 276.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
