RESOLUTION NO. 94-329

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has consistently supported the nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare through various programs and services designed to meet their special needs; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of funding for Fiscal Year 1994 in the amount of \$93,496., for the Rural Project Program for disabled 3 to 5 years old through the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Rural Project Program is being operated throughout the Tohono O'Odham Nation and has served many Tohono O'Odham children; and

WHEREAS, funds are to be used to assist in child find, screening, and other procedures for the early identification of children aged 3 - 5 inclusive, and for parent training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the budget modification incorporating funds for FY 1994 Rural Project Program and extension in accordance with

Act, as amended.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to
wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby
authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided
however, that any amendments affecting the funding
levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior
approval by this Council.**

which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,585.0 FOR; -0-

powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
