**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health care  
of the Children of the Nation a priority; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Legislative Resolution No.  
93-472 approving of the Nation's participation in a  
Demonstration Project to prevent the early onset of  
Diabetes in school children, funded by the National  
Heart Lung and Blood Institute; and**

**WHEREAS, in order to implement Resolution No. 93-472, a Contract  
Agreement must be established between the Department  
of Health Services of Gila River Indian Community (the  
"Program") and the Tohono O'Odham Nation (the  
"Contractor"); and**

**WHEREAS, a proposed Contract Agreement has been reviewed by  
the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee  
and the Attorney General's Office and both bodies have  
approved the proposed Contract Agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does not intend to waive its  
sovereign immunity by entering into this contract and**

**no terms of the contract shall be construed or  
interpreted as a waiver of the Nation's sovereign  
immunity.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council approves and endorses the Contract  
Agreement between the Department of Health Services  
of the Gila River Indian Community (the "Program") and  
the Tohono O'Odham Nation (the "Contractor") in order  
to implement Resolution No. 93-472 in which the  
Legislative Council approved the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation's participation in a Demonstration Project to  
prevent the early onset of Diabetes in school children,  
funded by the National Heart Lung and Blood Institute.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or his designated agent  
is hereby authorized to sign and execute the contract  
and such documents as may be required to fulfill the  
intent of this resolution.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
that any amendments affecting the funding or funding**

powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
