WHEREAS, the Nature Conservancy is a private, non-profit organization incorporated in the District of Columbia, dedicated to the preservation of the plants, animals, and natural communities that represent the diversity of life on earth, through protection of the lands and water they need to survive; and

WHEREAS, the Nature Conservancy desires to explore and pursue cooperative opportunities with the Nation to provide assistance for the purpose of maintaining and improving biological diversity on the Nation's lands; and WHEREAS, the Nature Conservancy has proposed a Memorandum

WHEREAS, the Nature Conservancy has proposed a Memorandum of Understanding (a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) by which it proposes to assist the Nation in the conservation of biological diversity; and

WHEREAS, the Nation's Executive Office supports the cooperative working relationship with the Nature Conservancy and recommends approval of the Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the Memorandum of Understanding with the Nature Conservancy in the form attached hereto, and that all activities of the Nature Conservancy within the Nation be conducted in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding.
