WHEREAS, Senator Inouye has requested that tribal representatives participate in further negotiations with state representatives over possible amendments to the IGRA with respect to the scope of Class III gaming.

WHEREAS, Senator Inouye's substitute amendment is an improvement over S.2230 as originally introduced and responds to many of the specific concerns in the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 94-284.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Nation urges the NIGA/NCAI Task
  Force to respond positively to Senator Inouye's
  substitute S.2230 which reflects Senator Inouye's
  serious and good faith response to the objections of
