**WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, the Tohono O'odham Utility
Authority and the Tohono O'odham Nation regularly
enter into Memorandum of Agreements for the purpose
of jointly engaging in community improvement projects;
and**

**WHEREAS, from time to time other public entities, such as the
Federal Environmental Protection Agency, collaborate in
these projects; and**

**WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1 (i)(3) of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation grants to the Legislative Branch
the authority to accept, upon completion such
community development projects on behalf of the
Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation
be granted authority to enter into Memorandum of
Agreements with the Indian Health Service and the
Tohono O'odham Utility Authority agreeing to accept,
upon completion, the following community development
projects:**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(i)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
