**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
Agriculture Extension Program under P.L. 93-638  
Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, notification was received on August 25, 1994 from the  
Department of Interior, through the Bureau of Indian  
Affairs, advising the Tohono O'odham Nation that funds  
are available for the purchase of material for repair and  
labor of the Tohono O'odham Nation southern  
boundary; and**

**WHEREAS, in order to expedite the process for accepting the funds,  
the Tohono O'odham Agriculture Extension Program was  
identified, as the recipient of the funds for use as  
prescribed by the Tohono O'odham Nation, Interior and  
Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, the modification was presented to the appropriate  
Legislative Oversight Committees.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it  
hereby approves the \$30,000.00 modification to the  
Agriculture Extension contract and authorizes  
expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,687.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 75.5 NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
