**WHEREAS, People from all backgrounds and races gathered on July  
29 & 30, 1994 at the Educational Conference on Human  
Rights for O'Odham in Mexico, to learn more about the  
Seven Principles for which the conference was  
established, they include:**

- 1. Land Rights and illegal encroachment in Mexico;**
- 2. Sacred Sites, ancient dwellings, catacombs, and ceremonial sites;**
- 3. Endangered species of plants and animals;**
- 4. Rights of O'Odham under international law;**
- 5. The impact of the North American Free Trade Agreement and other border/labor issues;**
- 6. Report on legal status of O'Odham in Mexico;**
- 7. Border Crossing Issues; and**

**WHEREAS, the Traditional O'Odham Leaders (TOL) agreed to gather  
on October 21, 1994 in the form of think tanks with all  
Sectors of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, especially its  
elected leadership, to develop a Strategic Plan to resolve  
the Seven Principles.**

powers vested in the Council by Section 10 of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
