(Appropriating \$12,672.00 for Border Crossing Workers)**

3 **WHEREAS, special arrangements have been made with the Mexican**
4 **Government to allow members of the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Nation to drive their vehicles into Mexico during the**
6 **period of September 28 through October 08, 1994 for the**
7 **Feast of St. Francis without having to pay the usual**
8 **import fee; and**

9
10 **WHEREAS, representatives of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the**
11 **Mexican Government agency INI will be at the Nogales**
12 **and Lukeville Ports of Entry from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.**
13 **during the aforementioned days to assist members of**
14 **the Tohono O'odham Nation in crossing the Inter-**
15 **national Border; and**

17 **WHEREAS, historically the number of workers of four (4) have been**
18 **sufficient at one site to effectuate the border crossing**
19 **process with minimum problems; and**

20
21 **WHEREAS, this year the eight recommended border workers will**
22 **have no less than two employees of the Nation who are**
23 **experienced with border crossing, present to provide**
24 **supervision of the process during the time period of**
25 **September 28, 1994 through October 08, 1994.**

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham**
28 **Legislative Council that eight (08) border workers will be**

3 herein with this resolution.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the funding amount of \$12,672.00 be
6 appropriated from the General Revenues of FY 1994.


7 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham

11 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the
12 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
13 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
14 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
15 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
