- WHEREAS, historically the number of workers of four (4) have been sufficient at one site to effectuate the border crossing process with minimum problems; and
- WHEREAS, this year the eight recommended border workers will have no less than two employees of the Nation who are experienced with border crossing, present to provide supervision of the process during the time period of September 28, 1994 through October 08, 1994.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that eight (08) border workers will be
