**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
Law Enforcement Services Program under an FY 1994
P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of one time DARE funding
for the Law Enforcement and Detention Services
Program which reflects an increase for FY 1994; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
of the contract shall be submitted for review and
approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council;
and**

**WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and
approval of an increase of \$5,000., for the Drug Abuse
Resistance Education Program (DARE) by the Law
Enforcement and Detention Services Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment
to the Law Enforcement and Detention Services Program
contract and requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to**

authorize expenditures in accordance with the attached
budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to
wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby
authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
provided however, that any amendment affecting the
funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 15TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a
meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,515.0 FOR;
-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 248.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to
the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
