RESOLUTION NO. 94-381

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has consistently supported the nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare through various programs and services designed to meet their special needs; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of funding for Fiscal Year 1994 in the amount of \$125,994., for the Early Intervention Program for Infants and Toddlers for Disabled 0 to 2 years old through the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, funds are to be used to assist in child find, screening, and other procedures for the early identification of children aged 0 to 2 inclusive, and for parent training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the budget incorporating funds for FY 1994 Early Intervention Program for Infants and Toddlers in accordance with the P. L. 102-119, Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, as amended.
