**RESOLUTION NO. 94-386**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council through  
Resolution #93-475 made a special appropriation to the  
tribal Law Enforcement Program in the amount of  
\$2,221,472., because of inadequate federal funding and  
lack of manpower to provide adequate police coverage  
to all areas of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the original budget submitted provided funding for  
fringe benefits at a higher percentage level of 28%  
instead of the standard 10% which realized cost savings;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the cost savings were reprogrammed for approved salary  
increases and for other line item accounts; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments or modifications affecting the funding  
and funding levels of tribal appropriations shall be  
submitted for review and approval by the Tohono  
O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, an amendment or modification has been submitted for  
review and approval whereby cost savings are  
reprogrammed in accordance with the attached budget.**

Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
