

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support and Designation of Land Sites for the
Planning of New Institutions [PONI] with the
Gu Achi District)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-403

WHEREAS, P. L. 99-570, the Omnibus Drug Enforcement, Education and Control Act, Title IV, Subtitle C, cited as the Indian Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act of 1986, authorized the construction or renovation of new or existing Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Centers for purposes of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 71-88, Resolution No. 342-88, and Resolution No. 08-89, approved and supported the Judicial Branch in identifying and implementing community based, rehabilitative programs of treatment and therapy for O'Odham Youth; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary did solicit the surrounding districts of Baboquivari, Schuk Toak and Gu Achi for land sites, and having been turned down by both Baboquivari and Schuk Toak Districts; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 1994, Gu Achi District did approve three (3) sites for the PONI Project, each site is approximately 700 feet by 700 feet, or the equivalent of ten (10) acres per site which is pursuant to Gu achi

District Resolution No. 0994-93, enacted September 17,
1994, quorum present with a vote of 6-FOR, 0-AGAINST, 4-
ABSENT; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the contract between this Nation and
Wyatt & Rhodes Architectural firm that three (3) sites will
be made available for site testings prior to the deadline
date, which has been proposed to be extended to
November 23, 1994; and

WHEREAS, any further delay will cause the project to incur
additional costs and jeopardize the current ranking
status of the Nation as published in the Federal Register,
Volume 58 No. 249, December 30, 1993 by the Department
of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council:

- 1) That the three (3) sites of 700 feet by 700 feet,**
equivalent to or about 10 acres, be designated in
the district of Gu Achi to be tested by the
consultant engineering firm of Wyatt & Rhodes.

2) **That the consultant engineering firm of Wyatt &
Rhodes commence site assessment study on
October 15, 1994 and be completed by November
23, 1994.**

3) **That upon completion of site assessment, the
recommended suitable site be designated as the
site for construction of the Juvenile Detention and
Rehabilitation Center.**


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 21ST. day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a
meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR;
-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(i)(2) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
