3 **WHEREAS, on September 21, 1994, the Chukut Kuk District Council**
4 **approved a \$140,674.00 District Patrol budget and**
5 **proposal to be forwarded to the Legislative Council for**
6 **funding; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the communities in Chukut Kuk District have for years**
9 **requested the establishment of a Ranger Program for**
10 **the protection of its people and property due to the**
11 **close proximity of the country of Mexico, which attracts**
12 **illegal activities such as violence, transporting of aliens,**
13 **contraband, and drugs, through our district; and**

14
15 **WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District recognizes the positive**
16 **initiatives the Tohono O'odham Nation's government is**
17 **implementing to promote equal protection of its laws,**
18 **including, "the maintenance of law and order... and**
19 **establish law enforcement agencies..." as set forth in the**
20 **Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council appreciates the**
23 **\$2,221,472.00 supplement to the Tohono O'odham Law**
24 **Enforcement, Memorandum of Understanding between**
25 **the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Joint Task Force**
26 **Six, as well as the potential FY 1995 funding for a Nation**
27 **wide Ranger Program; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the long term initiatives will not become fully**
4 **operational until a year from now; and**

5
6 **WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk district recommends the District Patrol**
7 **be a pilot program to learn from when preparing to**
8 **structure the Nation wide Ranger Program; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the gaming revenue distribution to the Chukut Kuk**
11 **District does not fully meet the needs of our constituents**
12 **and programs.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it**
14 **hereby approves a \$140,674.00 appropriation to the**
15 **Chukut Kuk District Council for the establishment of a**
16 **one year District Patrol.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the source**
19 **of the revenue be appropriated from the Nation's**
20 **General Fund.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham**
24 **Legislative Council on the 22ND day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a**
25 **meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 842.0 FOR;**
26 **490.0 AGAINST; 431.0 NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the**
27 **powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the**
28 **Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
