Programs, which each experienced an FY-94 Shortfall  
in available funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-413**

**WHEREAS, the 1994 fiscal year will end next Friday, September 30 at  
midnight; and**

**WHEREAS, certain sums of money have heretofore been  
appropriated by this body to fund Executive Branch  
(tribal) Programs; and**

**WHEREAS, certain of these programs will experience a savings in  
appropriated funds at the close of fiscal year 1994; and**

**WHEREAS, these "saved" funds revert back into the general fund at  
the close of the fiscal year and may not be carried  
forward; and**

**WHEREAS, the following Executive Branch (tribally-funded)  
programs will have the indicated savings at the close of  
FY-94:**

**WHEREAS, the following Executive Branch, tribally-funded programs will experience the indicated shortfall at the close of FY-94:**

**Identified FY-94 shortfall is \$339,252.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the main frame computer in the Accounting Department has been out-of-service since September 3, 1994 and as a result the actual anticipated deficit figures cannot presently be produced; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive has reason to believe that the aggregate of these deficits in addition to those enumerated herein will not exceed \$60,748.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive has demonstrated an anticipated shortfall in the amount of \$400,000.00 in the herein enumerated tribally- funded programs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council finds that there presently exists adequate Executive Branch program "savings" to fund the herein identified shortfalls; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council finds that it is  
in the best interest of the Nation and these Executive  
Branch Programs to authorize this one-time request to  
reprogram heretofore appropriated funds.**


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham  
Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman, on this  
single occasion, to reprogram \$400,000.00 in heretofore  
appropriated savings to fund the programs with the  
herein identified shortfalls.**

**The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council on the 22ND. day of SEPTEMBER, 1994 at a  
meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 404.0 FOR;  
1,099.0 AGAINST; 260.0 NOT VOTING; and 07 ABSENT, failed to pass  
because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by  
Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation.**
