

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization to Continue Executive Branch Operations)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-414**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Branch wishes to forward the FY '95 Budget with clear justification documenting the current availability of the Nation's revenue for the FY'95 period; and**

**WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Executive Branch to continue its fiscal operations pending the review and approval of its FY '95 budgets by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, in order that programs and services provided will not be interrupted, the Executive Branch is requesting an extension not to exceed 15 days of FY'95 to address the FY'95 Budgets.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby authorize the Executive Branch to continue operations at current spending levels in order that programs and services will not be interrupted.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this interim period will not exceed October 15, 1994.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that information requested on O'odham Construction and Law Enforcement be provided.**
