

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the Proposed Amendments to the Department of
Housing and Urban Development Regulations)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-444

WHEREAS, on July 20-22, 1994 the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's Housing Committee were invited to participate in Consultation '94 to review the comments on the Proposed Amendments to the Department of Housing and Urban Development Regulations; and

WHEREAS, on October 4 & 5, 1994 the Southwest Indian Housing Authority Association (SWIHAA) had a follow-up meeting on the Proposed Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation represented by the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners, and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's Housing Committee have reviewed the Proposed Regulations and recommends the following:

- 1. The Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledge the Tribal Sovereignty of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all Indian Tribes.**
- 2. That the 30% Rule be eliminated and the rental charge revert back to the original percentage of 20%.**
- 3. That the deduction for dependents and elderly be increased to reflect the deductions allowed under**

the Internal Revenue Services.

4. Allow deduction for Federal Income Withholding and F.I.C.A. Withholding to allow a more suitable and more realistic rent or house payment.

5. Review and improve the agreement between the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Department of Health and Human Services, and the Department of the Interior, and other agencies concerning assistance for the development of the projects under the program, for better interaction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the recommendations of the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners, and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's Housing Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority's Board of Commissioners and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's Housing Committee are authorized by this Council to make further comments on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and keep the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council informed of the changes.


