

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Temporary Relocation of IHS San Xavier Clinic
Services Off-reservation during Renovation Construction)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-447

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) did inform the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Health and Human Service Committee of the critical need to renovate/replace the HVAC, Electrical, and Plumbing system for the San Xavier clinic, and the plans by IHS-OEH&E to make the necessary repairs/renovation; and

WHEREAS, IHS' plans for the renovation/repairs for the San Xavier Clinic will require the temporary closure of the San Xavier clinic during the construction period; and

WHEREAS, IHS has determined that continuation of health services during the construction/renovation of the San Xavier clinic at an off-reservation site is more economical due to funding limitations, and IHS recommends providing health services off-reservation at the Kino Hospital facilities; and

WHEREAS, Tohono O'Odham Legislative Health and Human Service's committee did direct the Indian Health Service (IHS) to first obtain the approval of the San Xavier District; and

WHEREAS, at a special community meeting, held on October 8, 1994, wherein IHS presented their new proposal to the San Xavier District, the audience expressed their concerns

4 **endorsed (SXDC 10-94-01) IHS' plan.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'Odham**
7 **Legislative Council hereby endorses Indian Health**
8 **Service's proposal to continue providing health services**
9 **for The Wa:k community and other eligible individuals,**
10 **at the Kino site located off-reservation.**

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that IHS agrees to provide transportation**
13 **between the San Xavier District Offices and the Kino**
14 **Hospital location for San Xavier community residents.**

15
16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that IHS agrees to provide and insure**
17 **advance public notification regarding the renovation and**
18 **temporary relocation of the clinic.**

19
20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that IHS agrees to resume delivery of health**
21 **services from the San Xavier Indian Health Clinic no**
22 **later than October 31, 1995.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Legislative Council on the 14TH. day of OCTOBER, 1994 at a meeting**
26 **at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,552.0 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 211.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the**
28 **powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the**
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
